Description

A white porcelain group depicting a lively, pastoral scene featuring three figures in a countryside setting. 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underside. No clearly identifiable manufacturer's mark has been found. A connection to German productions, particularly those from Saxony and Thuringia, can be considered, though no definitive attribution is possible at this time. Period: 18th century. Note: chips, losses, and previous restorations, particularly on the most fragile elements such as flowers, foliage, and tips.
