Le Jardin des Moines Gallery, specializing in religious antiques and sacred art, presents this remarkable vermeil chalice by Hermann Cassau, dated 1913. Exquisitely crafted, this chalice features a design of great finesse, embellished with numerous enamel inlays and semi-precious stones, reflecting the care taken in its creation. It comes from the house of Hermann Cassau, a silversmith and manufacturer of liturgical objects based in Paderborn, Germany, whose workshop was founded in 1892. The chalice comes with its liturgical spoon, also made of silver and bearing German hallmarks. The set is crafted from 800-th silver, with a total weight of 960 grams. The chalice measures 24 cm in height, with a base width of 16.5 cm. It is presented in a wooden case from the Cassau workshop, which is included. In
