A significant blue-glazed earthenware dinner service, adorned with a marquis's crown on each piece. Manufactured in England by Brown - Westhead, Moore & Co., this dinner service was sold in France by the distributor A. Clain, located on Rue du Bac and Boulevard St. Germain in Paris. It consists of 100 pieces: - 12 dinner plates with a crown on the rim (diameter 24.7 cm)- 40 dinner plates with a crown on the rim (diameter 26 cm)- 30 dinner plates with a crown in the center of the plate (diameter 24.5 cm)- 18 soup bowls with a crown in the center of the bowl (diameter 26.2 cm). - 1 covered soup tureen - 4 stemmed fruit bowls- 4 stemmed fruit bowls- 4 serving bowls - 2 covered vegetable bowls - 1 stemmed bowl with a handle- 1 covered sauceboat - 1 sauceboat - 1 square bowl- 3 oval
