An elegant 19th-century Dutch pedestal table, made of blackened wood, resting on a circular base supported by three small round legs and featuring a superb twisted central shaft, typical of Dutch cabinetmaking from this period. The circular top is adorned with rich marquetry of flowers and foliage crafted from exotic woods in warm tones, which stand out delicately against the blackened background. The lower top echoes this decorative style with a perfectly balanced floral wreath, lending the piece as a whole a sense of great harmony. Both tabletops are accented by a remarkable border alternating ebony and bone inlays, a detail characteristic of certain 19th-century Dutch pieces. This contrast of materials highlights the piece's elegant silhouette and attests to exceptionally meticulous
