Description

Bronze with nuanced gilt patina depicting a pheasant with finely detailed plumage, portrayed in a natural and elegant pose. Traditionally associated with beauty, elegance and prosperity, the pheasant is presented here as a particularly refined decorative subject. The precise treatment of the feathers, head and long tail reflects Alfred Jacquemart's keen powers of observation, making him a major figure in 19th-century French animalier sculpture. The sculpture rests on its signed naturalistic base, mounted on a veined black marble plinth. Length of the bronze: 20 cm. Some slight wear on the patina consistent with its age.
