Description

A finely carved oak panel from 16th-century Flanders, featuring Gothic linenfold-style fluting with pointed-arch tops and deeply channeled vertical folds. The rhythmic carving evokes the architectural tracery of late-medieval design, balancing sculptural depth with refined linear symmetry. Originally part of a larger piece of furniture; likely a chest front or door panel, this fragment now stands beautifully on its own as a decorative wall element. The oak has developed a rich, warm patina over centuries, with subtle wear that enhances its authenticity. Structurally stable and well-preserved, this panel forms an exact matching pair with reference 26-0431 (photographed together but price per piece). It may be wall-mounted or displayed as a sculptural artifact, offering a tangible link to Flemish Gothic
