Description

"Nude Woman," watercolor signed "E. Godfrinon" in the upper right corner, for Ernest-Jean-Joseph Godfrinon. Ernest Jean Joseph GODFRINON (Ixelles, 1878 - Schaerbeek, 1927) was a Belgian painter born in Ixelles in 1878. He attended the academies in Brussels and Ixelles. He was a member of the group "Le Sillon," a Belgian artistic association founded in 1893 by a group of Academy students from the ashes of the Voorwarts collective as a counterweight to Symbolism. The desire for a return to traditional painting and the rich Flemish realist tradition drove the group's members toward a naturalist style. The dark, dense colors of his early work gradually lightened over time, giving rise to an increasingly luminous and vibrant palette, accompanied by a keen sensitivity to

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composition. A sensitive and refined artist, elegant in his chromatic harmonies, Godfrinon succeeds in combining an intimate sensibility with sophistication in his works.
