Description

Sculpture: a large 18th-century Lunéville faience group depicting a pastoral gallant scene. The glaze features ecru and white tones. There are some losses (specifically: three of the sheep's hooves, a finger on the female figure, and the tip of a leaf), and some glaze wear is evident. The vase and one handle have been reattached. Finding such a group from this period in perfect condition is extremely rare. While the subject dates to the same era as the work of Paul Louis Cyfflé, this piece was not created by him; it dates to around 1780. This pastoral scene is typical of the Louis XVI style. It is of fine craftsmanship and features multiple figures, animals, floral elements, and a cherub. Dimensions: 26 cm x 26 cm; height: 25.5 cm.
