Description

Large bronze okimono with champlevé enamel
A pilgrim monk standing on a rock, crafted from patinated bronze and adorned with champlevé enamel
This technique requires exceptional skill, especially when applied to complex, curved drapery such as the monk's robe
He holds a removable staff and is stroking his beard; a double gourd hangs from his belt
25 cm wide, 19 cm deep, and 57 cm tall
Total weight: 10.8 kg
In good period condition, with slight signs of wear consistent with its age and use
Japanese craftsmanship from the Meiji period (1868-1912)
