His landscapes quickly became a huge success, and Claude Jousset went on to hold numerous exhibitions in France, as well as in London and Vienna. He also won First Prize for French Landscape Painters at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1967. While he painted Paris and snowy scenes extensively, his views of
