Description

BIG CEREMONIAL URN FROM CAMBODIA DATING FROM THE FIRST HALF OF THE 20TH CENTURY, MADE OF TIN PLATE, USED BY BUDDHISTS DURING RELIGIOUS FESTIVALS, FOR OFFERINGS AT THE TEMPLE, WEDDING CELEBRATIONS, AND A PRESTIGIOUS DECORATIVE OBJECT. THIS URN CONSISTS OF A BOWL ON A PEDESTAL (PHAN) AND A COVERED CONTAINER OR BOWL. THE SET, VERY FINELY CHISELED, IS ENTIRELY DECORATED. ANGKOR VAT TEMPLE AND FLORA ARE DEPICTED ON THE BOWL AND ITS LID, WITH A LOTUS FLOWER SERVING AS A HANDLE. Beneath it are the scrollwork patterns that adorn the Phan, a wall decoration carved in the shape of a baluster inside
