Description

Henri OLIVE, known as "Olive des Martigues" (1868-1925) Seascape - Port of Martigues A beautiful oil on canvas depicting a lively view of the port of Martigues, with its traditional rowboats, sailboats, and Mediterranean facades reflected in the calm waters of the harbor. The work is signed "OLIVE" in the lower left corner and features a particularly expressive style, characterized by thick, textured brushstrokes, especially in the depiction of the water, boats, and architecture. The warm light and palette of ochres, blues, and grays perfectly capture the atmosphere of Provençal harbors. The subject matter, signature, and painterly style are highly consistent with the work of Henri Olive, known as "Olive des Martigues," a painter renowned for his depictions of Martigues and the Étang de
