A splendid pair of polychrome porcelain vases, entirely embellished with rich gold decoration, made in France in the early decades of the 19th century, in keeping with the refined and cosmopolitan style of French Neoclassical production. The vases, with their monumental amphora-like shape, feature large oval panels on the body, masterfully painted with scenes set in Turkey, brought to life by elegant figures in oriental attire and set against evocative landscapes. The scenes, characterized by a vibrant color palette and meticulous rendering of the figures, evoke the Orientalist style that was particularly popular in French art between the late 18th and early 19th centuries. The richly decorated frame is entirely gilded and features volute-shaped handles, embellished with floral

motifs, rosettes, and finely chiseled relief details. The body flows harmoniously into the cylindrical neck, topped by a wide rim and ending at the bottom with a stepped base resting on a substantial quadrangular pedestal, which is also richly decorated in gold. The combination of refined figurative painting, exuberant gilding, and the exotic nature of the scenes lends this pair a particularly elegant and prestigious character, making it a striking presence in a prestigious setting.
