Double-barreled pin-fire pistol, 19th century--1860-1870. 7.7 cm round, screw-off barrel, bearing the "ELG" hallmark from Liège--a star within an oval--and a serrated muzzle with a diameter of 10 cm. Stock engraved with floral motifs and a "G" hallmark crowned at the base of the barrels. Offset triggers beneath a wide, engraved trigger guard. Rail-type hammer with thumb checkering. Mechanism in working order. Smooth walnut stock with a brass thumb rest and a metal scallop-shaped cap that opens to access the primer reservoir.
