Description

Large glazed porcelain pot with a kiln-blue lid, set in a beautiful Louis XVI-style mount of chiseled and gilded bronze; the side handles are adorned with the heads of young nymphs. Resting on a square-section, fluted base. The lid handle is shaped like a pinecone. In good overall condition; very minor chips along the rim. Marked M.P. SEVRES on the base. Dated to the late 19th century. Total height 26 cm. Width 34 cm. Bowl diameter 26 cm, height 20 cm. Paul Milet, son of Optat Milet, a ceramist and chemist, ceased porcelain production in the aftermath of World War I. He collaborated with the national porcelain manufactory and received numerous awards, including a gold medal at the 1900 World's Fair.

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
