Boar's Head hallmark: 800 parts per thousand in Paris from 1838 to 1962 France, Restoration period (1815-1830) Total weight: 15.29 g Note: These small vials, which most often contained ammonia salts, were used by ladies prone to fainting spells caused by their overly tight dresses and corsets. When they felt unwell, they could inhale these salts to regain their composure.
