Boar's head hallmark: 800 parts per thousand in Paris from 1838 to 1962 Master's mark illegible France, Paris, Louis-Philippe or Napoleon III period (1830-1848-1870) Total weight: 19.95 g The small inner stopper is broken Note: This model of a smelling salt bottle with a chain and ring is rarer. The lady who owned it would hold it in her hand using this ring and could inhale the ammonia salts more easily when needed, during a reception or a ball. A beautiful collector's item.
