Description

Oil on canvas, signed and dated in the lower right corner and on the back "1928," unframed dimensions 65 cm x 54 cm, depicting the port of Dieppe with a French Navy ship in the foreground. Fernand Andrey-Prévost, born November 13, 1890, in the 11th arrondissement of Paris and died October 31, 1961, in the 18th arrondissement of Paris[1], was a French landscape painter. A student of Fernand Cormon, he exhibited **La Place Saint-André-des-Arts** at the Salon d'Automne and **Le Bateau blanc** and **Petite Place de banlieue** at the Salon des Tuileries. In 1923, at the Salon des humoristes, he presented wrought-iron animals, and in 1929, portraits of famous Montmartre residents. At the Salon des indépendants, he exhibited **Rue Saint-Séverin** and **La Rue des Gobelins sous la*
