The handle, richly adorned with plant motifs, extends into a long blade with an ogival tip. Beautifully modeled, chiseled, and gilded, with an antique patina featuring golden and brown hues. The handle bears the mark "SUSSE FRÈRES," a famous Parisian firm specializing in artistic bronzes. France - 19th century.
