Moulded and frosted glass vase with floral decoration, Czechoslovakia, circa 1930. An elegant flared vase with a hexagonal base, featuring a raised decoration of stylised flowers and foliage set against a finely hatched background. The gently ribbed sides open outward toward the rim, creating a subtle interplay of light between the transparent areas and the frosted sections. The composition, marked by its geometric purity, reflects the Central European Art Deco aesthetic, combining architectural rigor with refined decorative motifs. Moulded mark "Czechoslovakia" to the underside, indicating a Czech production, likely from the Bohemian glassworks renowned for the quality of their moulding and the precision of their floral relief designs.
