Description

A Louis XIV-era messenger's chest made of wood covered in brown embossed and gilded leather, with rich openwork ironwork decoration on all sides. The very slightly domed lid is topped with a carrying handle; the front retains its lock plate and wrought-iron latch. The interior is lined with original marbled paper. Late 17th - early 18th century. Dimensions: length 19 cm - depth 13 cm - height 8 cm. In good overall condition with a superb patina from use. Minor historical restoration beneath the carrying handle; normal wear and scuffing on the corners of the leather. The interior shows a few visible areas of material loss.
