The scene, inspired by the Tale of Genji, depicts elegant Japanese women beneath cherry blossoms. It is titled "Genji shiki no uchi Haru," meaning "Genji Through the Four Seasons: Spring." The set consists of three sheets forming a single large composition, printed on Japanese paper with beautiful polychrome coloring and numerous details in the costumes and landscape.
