Hercules and Omphale Engraved by Paul Girardet (1821-1893) after Edmond-Adolphe Rudaux (1840-1908). Printed and published by Goupil & Cie, Publishers, 1 October 1880. A fine, well-contrasted impression. 66.9 × 97.4 cm | 26.3 × 38.3 in -- sheet 38.7 × 68.1 cm | 15.2 × 26.8 in -- image The engraving is in good condition considering its age. Our restorer carefully cleaned the print to remove traces of age. The engraving had two tears in the margins, neither affecting the image nor the platemark: one on the left, in the middle, and the other at the lower right. These tears have been carefully restored. We invite you to examine the photographs carefully, as they form an integral part of the description and condition report of this engraving.
