Description

Henri-Paul Derycke (1928 - 1998) Bronze cast with brown patina Monogrammed HD, Susse foundry stamp. Dimensions excluding base: H 12 x W 12 x D 8 cm Dimensions of base: H 3.5 x W 15 x D 10 cm A Closer Look at the Work ® This piece presents an atrophied body, stripped down to the essentials: no head, arms, or feet, yet an intact presence. Far from suggesting incompleteness, this deliberate absence and fragmentation focus the eye on the internal dynamics of the forms, revealing the expressive power of a battered anatomy. The posture, marked by a subtle twist, creates a diagonal movement that brings the torso to life. The treatment of the material favors a raw approach, leaving traces of the initial modeling visible on the surface. This irregular texture catches the

light beautifully, with reflections that reveal the work's sensuous, fleshy forms. Through this intimate scale, the artist suggests the vulnerability of the flesh while revealing the intensity of an inner strength. Susse FoundryFounded in Paris in 1758, the Susse foundry is the oldest art foundry in France still in operation. Renowned worldwide for its technical excellence and the exquisite quality of its patinas, the firm has accompanied the evolution of sculpture through the centuries. Susse has placed its craftsmanship at the service of the greatest masters of the 19th and 20th centuries--casting works by artists such as Rodin and Carpeaux--and later collaborating with major figures of modern art, including Giacometti, Arp, and Richier. Today, as a certified *Entreprise du Patrimoine Vivant* (Living Heritage Company), the "Susse Fondateur" mark engraved on a bronze remains a guarantee of absolute craftsmanship for collectors.
