VERY RARE PLATE FROM THE LEPIC SET DISPLAYED AT THE WORLD'S FAIR OF 1889 ALONGSIDE THE ROUSSEAU SET. MARKED ON THE BACK: DEPOSE LÉVEILLE 74 BD HAUSMANN and, in recessed lettering, TERRE DE FER. SUPERB "MARINE" DECOR BY ARTIST LUDOVIC NAPOLEON LEPIC. VERY RARE PLATE FROM THE LEPIC SET PRESENTED AT THE 1889 WORLD'S FAIR NEAR THE ROUSSEAU SET. MARKED ON THE BACK: "DEPOSE LEVEILLE 74 BD HAUSMANN" and "TERRE DE FER" in intaglio. CREAM-COLORED CLAY AND BROWN COMBED PATTERN AROUND THE RIM.....SUPERB. SHORTLY BEFORE HIS DEATH IN

MARINE-INSPIRED DECORATIONS, THE
DESIGNS OF WHICH ARE COLLECTED IN
TWO ALBUMS. SET PRESENTED AT THE
1889 WORLD'S FAIR IN PARIS. LEPIC
WAS A PAINTER OF THE
BERCK-SUR-MER SCHOOL. A MOVEMENT
BRINGING TOGETHER IMPRESSIONIST
AND NATURALIST PAINTERS EXPLORING
MARINE THEMES. DECOR ENHANCED
WITH BRUSHSTROKES ON
EARTHENWARE FROM THE CREIL AND
MONTEREAU MANUFACTORY.
COMMISSIONED BY LEVEILLE FROM
LEPIC. SIGNATURE LISTED IN THE
SIGNATURE BOOK OF Creil and
MonterEAU. VERY RARE PLATES
DEPICTING THE SEA FROM LEPIC. SOME
PIECES WERE EXHIBITED IN 2017 AT
THE BERCK-SUR-MER MUSEUM. AND
LATER AT THE CREIL
MUSEUM. BEAUTIFUL PLATE WITH
STUNNING POLYCHROME DECORATION
IN PERFECT CONDITION. VERY LARGE
