Description

Tea caddy (natsume) for matcha tea used in the tea ceremony. This elegant, deep black lacquered natsume captures the beauty of hydrangeas through a refined combination of gold maki-e lacquer and raden, mother-of-pearl inlays. On the lid, the iridescent flowers shimmer in shades of blue, green, and purple against a black background enhanced by delicately shimmering nashiji, beautifully contrasted by the golden leaves and branches in maki-e lacquer. For the tea ceremony, the tea master selects his utensils according to the seasons, guests, and events... In Japan, the hydrangea is the primary symbol of the rainy season (tsuyu), which takes place in June and July. Artist: Osamu Tanaka Japan, 7.5 x 6.5 cm. With its original box signed by the artist.
