Description

Set of two Delf ceramic tiles, made of glazed terracotta with a white/gray background and blue patterns. Each tile features a different dog in the center of a circle--one standing still, the other running--with a "spider" pattern in the corners. The dogs are very lively and expressive, drawn in a schematic style; the artist has captured the animals' poses. These tiles come from an auction of a collection in the Netherlands; there is a descriptive label (in Dutch) on the back. Traces of plaster; shows signs of use; a few chips along the edges. Carefully packaged for worldwide shipping.
