These parts, though barely visible when the bracelet is worn, have been given a truly decorative treatment, attesting to the quality of the piece's craftsmanship. The combination of white gold and yellow gold also

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highlights the structure and articulation of the various motifs. The bracelet is equipped with a double-security clasp, complemented by two figure-eight-shaped side locks. The piece is in perfect condition.
