Description

A very beautiful gilded bronze clock from the Empire period, depicting a winged Apollo playing the lyre. A similar model, created by the famous bronze artist Claude GALLE (1759-1815), once adorned the bedroom of the Princess of Moskova, née Bonaparte. The chasing and gilding are of very high quality; the lower part of the arch has been restored, and the arrowhead has been replaced--see photos. This clock has been serviced, is in perfect working order, and comes with its key and pendulum. Dimensions: Height of arch 40 cm, height of head 37 cm, width 29 cm, depth 14 cm.
