Description

A pair of armchairs designed by Pierre Guariche and produced by Negroni in France around 1970. The design is based on the contrast between a geometric structure made of white laminated plywood, with exposed edges, and two thick cushions forming the seat and backrest. The generously cut side panels create a continuous profile that rises up to the backrest, while the black fasteners deliberately punctuate the white surfaces. Low-slung and generously upholstered, these armchairs reflect Pierre Guariche's exploration of simple, functional furniture suited to the new lifestyles that emerged in the late 1960s.
