"Campbell's Soup Can" stool designed by Dino Gavina in 1971 and produced by Ultramobile Simon, labeled "Omaggio a Warhol" on its original tag. Made of painted and screen-printed metal, it features the image of the Campbell's soup can made famous by Andy Warhol. Its removable lid allows it to be used as a seat, a small table, or a storage space. Dino Gavina thus transposes one of Pop Art's most recognizable motifs into furniture, within the context of Italian design experimentation in the early 1970s. Edition: Ultramobile Simon, 1971.
