Description

Oil painting, seascape signed by Édouard Jacques Dufeu--19th century. Oil on canvas, a generously sized seascape depicting boats in a harbor, signed by the painter Édouard Jacques Dufeu (1836-1900), born in Marseille. This painting is characterized by careful observation, a subtle rendering of light, and a realistic yet poetic approach to the subject. The highly sculpted frame is period-appropriate. On the back of the painting is an inscription: "G. Berne." During Dufeu's lifetime, Bellecour proved to be his devoted friend and, after his death, worked diligently to bring his works to light. Dufeu was a French painter, watercolorist, engraver, and illustrator--an independent and discreet figure in the 19th-century art scene. Around 1860, he moved to Paris, where he joined the studio of

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Charles Gleyre, the renowned teacher of many Impressionist painters. He later became a member of the Société des Aquafortistes, through which he published his first etchings, such as *Rue du Caire* (1862), followed by a series titled *Vues d'Égypte* (1865). He exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français from 1865 to 1890. His works can be found at the Musée d'Orsay, the Louvre (Department of Graphic Arts), and the Musée des Beaux-Arts de Lyon
