Description

A small forest encased in porcelain. This spherical vase by Camille Tharaud features a swirling design across its entire surface, depicting stylized ferns, fronds, and plant stems in a stunning palette of brown, hazelnut, and turquoise green. An iconic Limoges creation, crafted from glazed porcelain. The nuanced, almost marbled cream background lends beautiful depth to the design, while the short neck is accented with a thick brown border. The so-called "Fougères" design is part of the naturalistic vocabulary developed by Camille Tharaud during the interwar period. The composition completely envelops the spherical form and changes depending on the angle from which the vase is viewed. In very fine condition
