Description

Late 19th-century patinated bronze, created by the famous French sculptor Adrien Étienne Gaudiez. **Style & Allegory:** This academic sculpture depicts a female figure draped in flowing fabric, often associated with allegorical themes such as nature or the stars. The dynamic pose, the raised arms, and the rendering of the drapery billowing in the wind are highly characteristic of the Napoleon III era and the rise of Art Nouveau. A bronze cast with a brown patina resting on a circular, molded base. Sculptures by Gaudiez are generally no more than 70 cm tall, suggesting that this work was intended for an exhibition or art fair. It measures 120 cm--a rare find.
