Description

Rare covered glove box in Limoges porcelain, produced by the R. Delignières & Cie manufactory, active in Limoges from 1879 to 1900. Beyond its impressive dimensions, the piece features a sumptuous polychrome decoration on a celestial blue ground, enhanced by exceptional gilt ornamentation. Hand-painted floral bouquets, cartouches, scrolling foliage, volutes and Rococo-inspired motifs create a richly elaborate decorative composition. The gilding is in remarkable condition, exceptionally fresh and abundant, beautifully highlighting the entire decoration. The underside bears the characteristic "R. Delignières & Cie Limoges" mark, together with the "D.C. France" mark under the glaze, allowing the manufacture to be precisely dated to the period 1879-1900. Thanks to its impressive
