Description

An elegant pair of gilded bronze wall sconces attributed to Jules Leleu, a remarkable example of the refinement of French design in the 1950s. Each sconce features two light arms with and harmonious lines, ending in conical bronze candle holders with a patina that hold truncated cone-shaped lampshades. The central decoration consists of an openwork geometric motif forming an elegant interlacing of curves and rhombuses, characteristic of the decorative vocabulary developed by Maison Leleu in the postwar years. The composition perfectly combines the geometric precision inherited from Art Deco with the lightness of form that characterizes the 1950s. The arms, which end in delicate scrolls, add movement and sophistication to the piece, while the beautiful patina of the bronze
