Description

An expressive oil painting by British artist Walter Reeves (active between 1882 and 1900), depicting two hunting dogs resting at the edge of a wood. One is sitting, alert, while his companion lies down beside him; both are staring intently at a point outside the frame. The rich autumnal browns, deep greens, and slightly cloudy sky complement the dogs' white, brown, and black coats. A textured brushstroke lends depth to the wooded setting, while the carefully observed postures give each animal its own distinct character. Walter Reeves (active between 1882 and 1900) painted rural subjects and hunting scenes until his death in 1900. His subjects notably included hunting dogs in landscapes. His work is part of the British tradition of animal painting, which celebrates dogs and their place in

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country life. Signed "Reeves" in the lower left corner, the painting is set in a handcrafted, gilded Italian frame from a later period, which highlights the warm tones of the painting.
