An elegant duchesse chair in two pieces, consisting of a chair and its footrest, made of molded wood and richly carved with flowers, foliage, and scrollwork. The backrest and side panels are scalloped, resting on curved legs characteristic of the Louis XV style. The footstool is stamped "Philippe-Joseph Pluvinet," who was admitted as a master in 1754. The set is upholstered in a beautiful raspberry-colored damask velvet. Period: Louis XV, mid-18th century. Mark: Philippe-Joseph Pluvinet, master craftsman since 1754. Condition: Previous restorations, minor chips, and traces of woodworm damage. Dimensions: Armchair: height 96 cm, width 70 cm, depth 70 cm. Footrest: height 45 cm, width 69 cm, depth 72 cm.
