This type of glassware, now highly sought after, offers a rare insight into production methods and tableware usage during this period. The glass exhibits beautiful oxidation as well as an antique patina, with subtle variations and surface irregularities that fully contribute to the piece's historical and aesthetic character. This patina, naturally acquired over the centuries, gives the goblet a particularly intriguing presence and underscores its age. The piece has undergone a restoration that
