This refined scene highlights the hero Renaud, seduced by the sorceress Armide in a bucolic landscape animated by putti, rendered with a delicate palette and a touch imbued with the Rococo spirit. The work reflects the 18th-century rediscovery of Fragonard's major compositions. Unsigned oil on canvas, presented in a substantial carved and gilded wooden frame.
