The white biscuit porcelain contrasts harmoniously with its elegant sky-blue glazed pedestal, accented with gold fillets, lending the piece an air of refinement and simplicity. The base bears the mark of the Imperial Sèvres Manufactory as well as the date 1868, attesting to its official production by the prestigious French manufactory during the Second Empire.
