Description

Description The vase has an inverted ovoid shape, finely painted with a Napoleonic battle scene. The lids are adorned with a gilded "N" in relief and a crown, flanked by oak and laurel branches with berries. The neck features a spread-winged eagle, while the flared base is decorated with golden designs and inscribed with the date of the Battle of 1807, resting on a recessed gilt bronze structure. The date 1807 refers to the Battle of Friedland, fought on June 14, 1807, marking Napoleon's victory over Russia and leading to the Treaty of Tilsit with Alexander I. Signature: H. Desprez, Sèvres.
