Description

A Belgian Art Deco side chair from the 1920s, crafted in solid oak with a distinctly modernist sensibility. Its geometric, block-like form is softened by chamfered edges and a hand-carved zigzag stretcher that adds a touch of sculptural rhythm. The seat and rectangular back panel are upholstered in deep forest-green fabric, bordered with aged brass dome-head nails that lend a subtle decorative accent. The chair retains its original patina, showing the warm glow of aged oak and the integrity of traditional joinery. The upholstery is clean and well-preserved, complementing the architectural simplicity of the frame. A fine example of Belgian craftsmanship from the interwar period, balancing artisanal solidity with modernist restraint. Part of a small matching set with 26-0383 and 26-0385.
