This large badge (8 cm) features a particularly interesting depiction of Saint Cornelius, Bishop of Ninove, a religious figure venerated in the former Netherlands. He is traditionally associated with protection against illness, particularly nervous and convulsive disorders, which explains the popularity of his cult and the widespread circulation of small devotional objects bearing his image. His iconography naturally depicts him as a bishop, with the attributes of his ecclesiastical office: mitre, chasuble, and sometimes a crosier. The sign
