Description

Large portico clock in marble and gilded bronze. A large model with double columns in black and white marble, richly adorned with chiseled bronze gilded with mercury, featuring a dual matte and glossy patina. At the top is an eagle with outstretched wings. The dial, signed by a renowned 18th-century clockmaker, indicates the days of the month. It therefore chimes the hours and half-hours and displays the day of the month. This piece dates from the late Louis XVI period. Large model measuring 61 cm high, 42 cm wide, and 12 cm deep. This clock is complete, has not been cleaned, and requires servicing by a clockmaker. For more information, please feel free to contact me.

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
