Carved and gilded wood frame. Tuscany, 19th century. Clear opening 70 x 124 cm - Rebate 73 x 127 cm - Overall 96 x 149 cm. Carved and gilded wood throughout. The frame is entirely pierced with volutes and acanthus leaves, following a decorative repertoire of Florentine Baroque tradition widely revived by Tuscan workshops during the 19th century. The rebate is defined by a narrow moulding carved with small leaves, cleanly separating the pierced profile from the opening. The gilding, even and well preserved, gives the surface a warm and consistent tonality. Condition report: Generally good state of preservation.
