A large full-length portrait depicting Queen Victoria (1819-1901) in court dress and a ceremonial cloak, flanked by the insignia of the British monarchy. This composition is based on the famous portrait painted by Sir David Wilkie. The sovereign is depicted with great elegance against a backdrop of classical architecture, clad in her royal cloak trimmed with ermine and wearing her tiara, while the imperial crown rests on a cushion at her side. The work subtly captures the essence of 19th-century British official portraiture. Oil on re-stretched canvas, set in a large carved and gilded wooden frame. Period: 19th century.
