Dragon Helmet, Model 1872, Modified 1874, Third Republic. Helmet made entirely of chrome-plated steel with brass trim. Consists of a helmet shell, a and a leather-lined neck guard, both edged with a brass band folded over the outer rim. The front band is embossed with a blazing orb framed by laurel branches. Leather chinstraps covered with brass scales. Brass plume holder. Crest consisting of two wings embossed with a series of 12 gadroons tapering toward the back. Faceplate featuring a palmette at the bottom and the head of Medusa at the top. Cover plate imitating Medusa's hair with a serpent. Mane made of black horsehair approximately 68 cm long. Inner leather cap cut into seven wolf's teeth.ABE condition. Shows signs of use, visible in the photos. Worn headpiece. Size 56/57 cm.-
