Description

We are presenting this set of three hand-painted porcelain plates in frames (made of exotic woods) from China, of course. All three were displayed together in the estate where we purchased them. The largest is a Jengderhem (CIBAUJ) plate, featuring a court painting style depicting Taoist immortals in the clouds --likely produced in the late 19th century (Qing Dynasty) or early 20th century (Republican era). One of the two small framed plates (Cibenhua) is hand-painted with "famille rose" enamels. From the same period, featuring a Chinese folk theme related to celebrations and wishes for happiness. The thread you see is not a strand of hair or a flaw; it is simply a thread connected to the multicolored, auspicious clouds where a small celestial creature is depicted. The second is a Chinese porcelain

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plaque likely depicting the god of longevity
(Sbron Xing) or a sage surrounded by children
holding a "fu" symbol of happiness. From the
same period. All are in perfect condition
