An elegant pair of Limoges porcelain bowls from L. Bernardaud & Cie, "Barbeaux" model. The design features delicate, multicolored barbeaux flowers scattered across the white porcelain. The rim is accented by a rich decorative band alternating between friezes and medallions, with the entire design enhanced by gilded fillets and ornaments. This design follows in the tradition of floral tableware inspired by the 18th century; the barbeau--or cornflower--was particularly popular in porcelain designs during the reigns of Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette.
